

Processing instructions

The lacquer for sheet wax can be applied very thin with a brush on the sheets. After drying the lacquer inhibits partial solution of the wax sheets caused by the containing solvents in the release agent, which is applied afterwards. Furthermore it prevents trickling down of the PVA-film on the wax sheets.

In General

Sales units / packages: 1,000 l / 5,000 l

Storing

Keep away from sources of ignition

Do not store outdoors.

In case of extreme cold do stabilize to 15° C.

Shelf life is indicated on the labels
